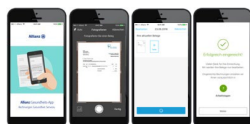

Consent to collection and use of health data and release from the confidentiality obligation

The declarations of consent and of releases from the confidentiality obligation printed below have for the most part been drawn up in consultation with the German insurance association V (GDV) with the data protection supervisory authorities.

The provisions of the German Insurance Contract Act, of the EU General Data Protection Regulation that went into effect on May 25, 2018, of the German Data Protection Act, and of other data-protection legislation do not contain sufficient bases in law for the collection, processing and use of health data by insurance companies. In order to have permission to collect and use your health data for the policy, we, your Allianz Private Krankenversicherungs-AG (hereinafter: •the Insurer), thus require your consent pursuant to data-protection law. In order to also gain permission to collect and use the results of diagnostic genetic examinations (hereinafter: genetic data) that you have provided for exclusive use in connection with investigations of claims, we need your consent in this connection as well. Our employees have a confidentiality obligation pursuant to Section 203 of the German Criminal Code (hereinafter: confidentiality obligation). That is why we, as a company providing private health and long-term care insurance, also require your release from the confidentiality obligation in order to forward your health data or other data protected by the confidentiality obligation, such as e.g. the fact that a contract with you exists, or your customer number or other identifying data, to others, e.g. providers of assistance, logistics or IT services.

We use automatic decision-making procedures to make determinations regarding your claims and insurance benefits, in order to ascertain and efficiently process your contractually agreed claims. As a rule, these procedures are based on the provisions of law. When processing health and genetic data, however, there are a few constellations in which we will require your consent.

The following statements of consent and releases from confidentiality obligations are indispensable for the execution of the insurance contract. If you fail to submit these, processing of your benefits claims will usually not be possible.

Where processing and use of your data is based on an express consent, you may revoke this consent with future effect at any time. If your consent is required to carry out the contract, a withdrawal will result in our inability to continue to provide the benefits in question.

These statements concern the handling of your health data, the genetic data you have provided for verification of the benefit obligation, and other data protected by the confidentiality obligation

- by us ourselves (under 1.) and
- when transferring these data to entities outside of the Insurer (under 2.).

1. Collection, storage and use by the Insurer of the health and genetic data•) you have provided.

I hereby grant the Insurer permission to collect, store and use the health data disclosed by me where this is necessary to the performance of the insurance contract.

I hereby grant my consent that the claims for insurance benefits made within the scope of the contractual agreements may be automatically decided if health data are processed in the procedure.

I hereby grant my consent to the Insurer's future collection, storage and use of genetic data provided, exclusively for the purpose of investigation of its benefits obligation within the scope of performance of the contract.

2. Forwarding of your health data, genetic data and other data protected by the confidentiality obligation to entities outside of the Insurer

We place the following entities under a contractual obligation to comply with the regulations governing data protection and data security.

2.1 Delegation of tasks to other entities (companies or individuals)

Certain tasks – such as processing of claims or telephone customer support, for instance – that may result in collection, processing or use of your health data as well as of the genetic data made available by you for claims, may not be performed by us in some instances. To this end, we have delegated these tasks to other companies of the Allianz Deutschland Group, or to another entity outside of the Allianz Deutschland Group. If your data subject to protection by the confidentiality obligation are forwarded, we will require your release from the confidentiality obligation for ourselves and, to the extent necessary, for the other entities.

We maintain a continuously updated list of the entities and categories of entities with which agreements are in place for the collection, processing or use, on our behalf, of

data or health and genetic data protected by the confidentiality obligation. The tasks delegated to the individual entities can be found in this list. The currently valid list is attached directly to the statements 1*). A current list can also be found online at www.allianz.de/datenschutz or requested from us (Allianz Private Krankenversicherungs-AG, 10870 Berlin, Telephone +49 (0)8 00.4 10 01 09, krankenvsicherung@allianz.de). For onward transmission of your health data and genetic data to, and for use by the entities shown in the list, we require your consent.

I hereby consent that the Insurer may transmit my health data, and the genetic data provided by me exclusively for the purpose of investigating its benefits obligation, to the entities set forth in the above-mentioned list, and that the health and genetic data may be collected, processed and used there for the purposes set forth to the same extent as would be permitted by the Insurer. Where necessary, I hereby release the employees of the Allianz Deutschland Group and of the other commissioned entities from their confidentiality obligation relative to the onward transmission of health data, genetic data and other data protected by the confidentiality obligation.

2.2 Forwarding of data to independent insurance agents

We never disclose information concerning your health, or any genetic data, to independent insurance agents. Under the following circumstances, however, it cannot be ruled out that insurance agents will be provided with information from which they can draw conclusions about your health, or information that relates to your contract and is subject to the protections of the confidentiality obligation.

Where required for advisory purposes relative to the contract, the agent assisting you may obtain information as to whether and, in the event, under what circumstances (e. g. involvement of experts, acceptance with risk surcharges, exclusions of certain risks or waiting times) your contract can be accepted.

The agent who has brokered your policy learns that the contract has been concluded, and the contents thereof. He or she also learns whether risk surcharges or exclusions of certain risks have been agreed.

In the event of a change from the agent assisting you to another agent, the contract data, together with information about existing risk surcharges and exclusions of certain risks may be forwarded to the new agent. In the event of a change from the agent assisting you to another agent, you will be notified before health data are forwarded and advised of your right to object.

I hereby consent that the Insurer may, to the extent required, forward my health data and other contract information subject to the confidentiality obligation to the independent insurance agent responsible for my contract under the above-mentioned circumstances, and that this information may be collected, stored and used there for advisory purposes

Data Sheet for Private Health Insurance Occupational Health Insurance Preventative Health Provision Tariff

This leaflet will provide you with some initial information about the insurance policy, arranged by the policyholder (meaning your employer, for example) on your behalf. The information contained herein is not exhaustive. The binding contractual content is defined solely by the enclosed Certificate for the Insured Person and the Terms and Conditions of Insurance provided to the policyholder.

1. Who are the parties to the contract?

The policyholder is our contractual partner. It has concluded the insurance contract with us, and it pays the premiums. However, you are directly entitled to claim the insured services from us.

2. What are the applicable terms and conditions of insurance?

The basic conditions are the Terms and Conditions of Insurance for the tariff concluded.

The policyholder can provide you with a copy of the Terms and Conditions of Insurance.

3. What insurance cover has been agreed?

The main information concerning your insurance protection is set out below. Further details are regulated in the Terms and Conditions of Insurance.

The insurance covers the costs for medical screenings and check-ups for the early detection of illness/disease, up to the maximum rates set out in the Scale of Fees and Charges for Physicians in Germany (*Gebührenordnung für Ärzte, GOÄ*). This entitlement is limited to the services and items listed in the GOÄ, up to the amount of the specified number:

- 100% of the costs remaining following the advance payment by the statutory health insurance (SHI) or 100% of the total costs incurred, insofar as these are not eligible for an allowance; the specified number applies following each medical screening for a period of two insurance years each time, or for a period of one insurance year in the case of prenatal screenings.

The following applies to the "insurance year":

The first insurance year commences upon the agreed start of the insurance cover. It will end on 31 December of the same calendar year. The following insurance years correspond to the relevant calendar year.

Further details on services and maximum limits can be found on the reverse side.

4. What services are excluded?

The insurance protection does not cover all situations. Our obligation to pay for services under the policy is excluded in the following cases, for example:

- Treatment provided by spouses, registered civil partners, children or parents (we reimburse proven material costs in accordance with the tariff),
- Screening services not contained in the list of tariffs.

This list is non-exhaustive. The contractually excluded services are set out in full in the Terms and Conditions of Insurance.

5. What are your duties of notification and disclosure?

Please note: Your statutory health insurance constitutes your primary cover. You must therefore tell us about the benefits/services provided by a statutory paying agency or another private agency. Send us the duplicate invoice containing the refund endorsements.

6. When does the insurance cover start and end?

The insurance cover commences at the time specified in your Certificate for the Insured Person.

The insurance contract is for a fixed term. It will therefore end at the time you begin receiving a pension, but no later than at the end of that month in which you turn 70 years old. Insurance cover will otherwise end if the insurance contract is terminated by the policyholder, or if you no longer belong to the group of persons insured under the group insurance contract. The contractually-defined grounds for termination of cover are set out in full in the Terms and Conditions of Insurance. To find out if you are still insured during the period of parental, caregiver or unpaid leave, please contact your personnel department. You can ask your insurance broker about the possibility of extending your insurance cover.

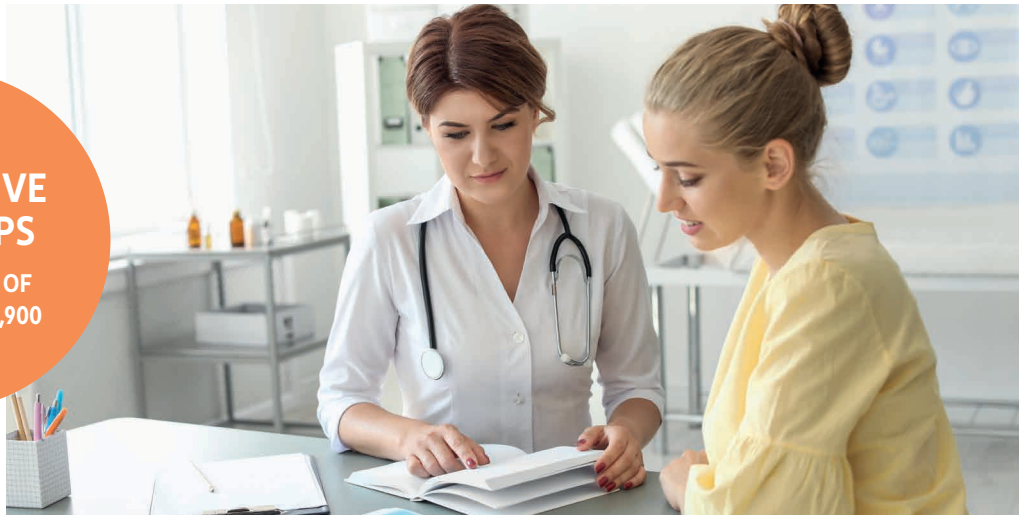

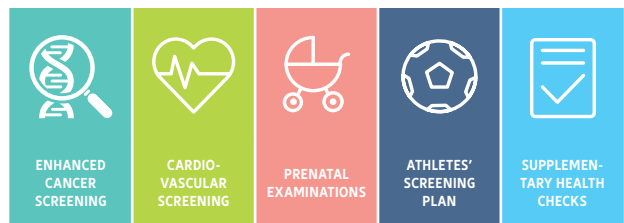

INFORMATION ON THE USE OF YOUR DATA

Insurance, prevention and capital formation are a matter of trust. That's why it's very important to us, to respect your right to privacy. This applies particularly to the handling of your personal data.

Purposes and legal bases of data processing

An insurance contract cannot be concluded or executed without processing of your personal data (hereinafter: "data").

If you apply for insurance coverage, we need the disclosures you provide in support of the insurance contract. If the insurance contract takes effect, we process your data for the execution of the contractual relationship, e.g. to verify timely settlement of receivables. We need particulars about a claim in order to verify the occurrence and scope of the insured event, measures for health care and, where appropriate, the existence and settlement of reimbursement claims. Furthermore, we use these data for viewing and maintenance of the entire customer relationship, for instance when consulting relative to an adjustment of contract, or for purposes of comprehensive information. In addition, we require your data to comply with regulatory requirements, for business management or to generate insurance-specific statistics, e.g. for the development of new rates and products as well as their calculation.

We process your data in compliance with the provisions relevant to data protection in the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) that went into effect on May 25, 2018, and of the German Insurance Contract Act (VVG), the German Data Protection Act (BDSG) and all other relevant legislation. Our Company is also committed to the "Behavioral rules for dealing with personal data by the German insurance industry," which specify the legal requirements for the insurance industry. These can be found online at www.allianz.de/datenschutz.

Your data are processed for pre-contractual measures and for the performance of your contract. If this requires special categories of personal data, such as health data, we generally require your consent unless legislative reasons justify this use of your data, e.g. in relation to preventive health measures or the compilation of statistics.

We also process your data where this is necessary to protect legitimate interests of our own or of third parties. This situation may arise in particular in the case of:

- guarantee of IT security and IT operations,
- prevention and clarification of criminal offenses, particularly through data analysis to combat abuse,
- for market and opinion surveys,
- to promote our own insurance products and other products of the companies of the Allianz Deutschland Group and their cooperation partners. In so doing, we consider aspects such as the portfolio of products you have booked with us and your personal situation in order to be able to offer you product recommendations that suit your individual situation.

In addition, we process your data to fulfill legal obligations (e.g. regulatory requirements, storage and proof obligations under commercial and tax law or advisory obligations).

Categories of recipients of personal data

Agents:

The independent agent who has brokered your contract learns the content with which the contract was concluded. We also provide the data we need to provide assistance with your insurance contracts to the relevant agent who processes these data for consultation purposes.

Specialized companies of our group of companies, as well as external service providers:

Specialized companies of our group of companies perform certain data-processing tasks for the companies affiliated with the Group, based on jointly usable procedures. Data of applicants and insured persons can be processed in centralized procedures such as telephone calls, postal communication, and collections by these Group companies.

We also enlist the assistance of external service providers to fulfill our contractual and legal obligations.

You will find a list of the contractors and service providers we use, and with which the business relationships we have are not just temporary, as well as the companies of our Group that participate in centralized data processing, in the overview presented in the statements on data processing and in the most up-to-date version shown on our website at www.allianz.de/privacy; you may also request this list from us.

Further recipients:

We can also transmit your data to other recipients, e.g. to the authorities for the purpose of fulfilling legal notification obligations.

Duration of data storage

As a matter of principle, we delete your data as soon as they are no longer required for the purposes set forth above. We retain your data for the period during which claims can be brought against our company (statutory limitation period of three or up to 30 years). We also store your data if and insofar as we are required to do so by law. Corresponding notification and storage obligations arise from the German Commercial Code and the German Tax Code. Under these laws, the storage periods are up to ten full years.

Rights of data subjects

Using the above-mentioned address, you may request information about the personal data stored about you as well as, under certain circumstances, rectification or erasure of your data. You may also have a right to restrict the processing of your data as well as a right to surrender of the data you have provided in a structured, conventional and machine-readable format.

Right of opposition

You may object to processing of your data for direct-advertising purposes. If we process your data in an exercise of legitimate interest, you may object to this processing for reasons owing to your personal situation.

You can reach our data protection officer at the address indicated above.

You also have the option of contacting a data protection supervisory authority. The authority with jurisdiction in our case is: The Bavarian State Office for Data Protection Supervision in Ansbach.

Data transmission to a third country

If we should happen to transmit data to service providers outside of the European Economic Area (EEA) subsequent to May 25, 2018, then the transmission is made only if the EU Commission has verified that the third country has an appropriate level of data protection, or if there are other suitable guarantees for data protection in place (e.g. binding intra-company data-protection regulations or standard EU contractual clauses). You can call these up online under www.allianz.de/daten-schutz or request them from us.

Automated decision of individual cases

Based on the particulars we query when you apply for a policy, we use digital procedures to decide whether to conclude the contract, and the amount of the insurance premium to be paid by you. We use automated procedures to decide the particulars of the insurance claim, based on the data stored about your contract as well as, where appropriate, information obtained in this connection from third parties (such as hospitals). The automated decisions are based on rules previously fixed by the Company for the review and weighting of the information involved:

Automated decisions about your claims for insurance benefits are based on the contractual arrangements agreed with you, such as the insurance policy and the General Terms of Insurance as well the provision of the Scale of Fees for Physicians (GOÄ), Dentists (GOZ), Naturopaths (GebOH) or the German Hospital Fees Act as well as the German Hospital Payment Ordinance. We also factor the health data we have processed about you in the review of your benefits.
